

Digital Printing

Short Run Printing

Offset printing has been the dominant form of book printing for nearly 100 years. In the offset printing model, the more copies a publisher prints, the lower the cost-per-unit becomes. The economics of offset encourage book publishers to publish thousands of copies per book to drive down that per unit cost. Our web off set department has been started keeping in mind the requirements of a Publisher. We have an array of machines catering to different cut-offs to suit various requirements.




Our Bindery lines provides infinite variety of capabilities. Our multiple production lines handle almost any type of finishing operation including challenging folding configurations:



Types of Paper – Paper Options

Paper types refers to the finish of the paper, this affects the look of the pages rather than the feel or the weight.



Paper Stocks

The paper stock is the weighting of the paper. As a general rule, a higher stock paper is a little more expensive to print on, but higher stock is also perceived as being higher quality.

70gsm - Uncoated

Suitable for black and white printing.

Thinner paper gives a more traditional, 'old-timely' feel.

Lowers the weight of your book which can cut costs on international shipping.

80gsm - Uncoated

Our standard paper for black and white books.

Costs slightly more than 70gsm, but not significantly.

Perfect for novels, biographies and poetry books.

100gsm - Uncoated

Our standard paper for colour books

Also works well as a heavier alternative for black and white books, particularly A4 books.

Perfect for autobiographies, anthologies, history books.

115gsm (Gloss or Silk)

Slightly heavier than 100gsm, but with a gloss or silk finish.

Works best in books / booklets with a lot of colour.

120gsm - Uncoated

Provides an outstanding finish for colour pages.

Work perfectly as colour inserts in black and white books.

Best for brochures, presentations and colour inserts in biographies.





135gsm (Gloss or Silk)

A high quality, thick paper stock.

Can make colour pages look more vibrant and sharp

Perfect for leaflets and flyers

170gsm (Gloss or Silk)

Our heaviest paper, very strong and durable.

Provides a beautiful, vibrant finish.

Works great for postcards, menus, and posters.

250gsm

Our standard cover card.

Recommended for the majority of the books we print.

Perfect for novels, anthologies, biographies, children's books, poetry collections and more.

300gsm

A slightly heavier cover stock.

A little more expensive than 250gsm, but not significantly.

Works brilliantly on recipe books, manuals, workbooks and children's books.

Children's Books	7.5 × 7.5, 7 × 10, 10 × 8
Text Books	6 x 9, 7 x 10, 8.5 x 11
